History

Serrill J. Sharpless¹ 1868-1934, was born in West Chester, PA, the son of Samuel Emlen and Martha Serrill Ash Sharpless. Samuel Sharpless² was the owner of a lucrative brick and coal business in West Chester. He also started a lumber and building supplies business in the property on Washington, Walnut and Matlack Streets. The storage sheds at the old Frazer Branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad on Matlack Street were used to store lumber³. Serrill Sharpless joined his father in the lumber business. His brother was P.M. Sharpless, who made a considerable fortune in cream separators.

Serrill Sharpless married Eleanor Scott Walsh, 1868-1934 of Yonkers, NY in 1893 in West Chester, PA. They made their home at 132 E. Washington St. beside the lumber yard. They had one daughter, Vivian who was born in 1895.

The couple moved to Newtown, Bucks County, PA in about 1909⁴ where Sharpless took up farming and raised pedigeed Swiss goats. Vivian married Phill Glenn Byrd in 1917⁵ and lived in Center Square, Montgomery County, PA. The couple had one son, Phill Glenn Byrd, Jr. Serrill and Eleanor Sharpless died within seven months of each other in 1934. They were buried at Buckingham Friends Meeting.

Collection Scope and Content Note

The Serrill J. Sharpless collection is a group of photographs taken by an amateur photographer recording his home, family and business interests in West Chester and Bucks County, Pennsylvania between 1907-1911. Included are portraits of Vivian and Eleanor Sharpless with friends and pets as well as views along East Washington St., West Chester, PA where Sharpless lived and worked at the lumberyard. Included is a view of the railroad turntable at Matlack St., West Chester, PA.

Other views in Chester County, PA record Birmingham Meeting, the Brandywine Creek, Bower's Mill and Abiah Taylor's house in East Bradford Twp., Grubb's Mill area along Valley Creek, a bridge near Embreeville and a roadway near Downingtown Water Works. A house in Wayne with Sharpless' relatives on the porch is included.

Also documented are goats raised by Sharpless at his farm in Newtown, Bucks County, PA. George School and Neshaminy Creek, Bucks County are included. Pictures taken while on vacation at Ocean City, New Jersey depict bathers on the beach, life saving station and the ship Sindia run aground. Views on the Delaware River at Trenton record activity on wharves and with fishermen.

The reference prints were made in CCHS darkroom by volunteer Mary Painter in 2009. The glass plate negatives were contact printed on Ilford photographic paper, developed using Dektol and Kodak chemistry. The prints were thoroughly washed in a rotating print washer.
