The Benjamin M. Walker Collection Finding Aid

Introduction

Biographical Information

Benjamin M. Walker (b. 1883), son of Benjamin S. (1851–1910) and Margaret Mifflin Walker (1857–1925), long time residents of West Chester, was a Philadelphia printer and amateur photographer. Walker married the former Lillian Mercer (b. 1893) circa 1909 and the couple resided in Philadelphia and Montgomery counties.

Overview/Scope and Content

This collection consists of 179 photographs of Benjamin M. Walker, his family [and friends], and various scenes in Chester and nearby Delaware and York counties. The collection primarily depicts people, houses, public buildings and monuments, bridges, and creeks. A small file of early twentieth century commercial and self-made postcards compliments the collection. The photographs are estimated to date from the 1860s to perhaps 1920, with the majority of them dating 1900–1910. It is noteworthy that some of the photos predate the photographer so it must be assumed that Mr. Walker did not produce them, but probably inherited them from older family members.

Files 1–11 are organized geographically (Chester County, Delaware County, York/Media, and unknown locations) and subdivided by subject, such as dwellings, bridges, railroads, etc. Those studying local history, topography, or architecture may find these useful. Files 12–18 are photos of people and are organized by individual, group, or family identity. These, along with file 19 which contains several tombstone images, may be of particular interest to the genealogist. Finally, files 20 and 21 contain [early twentieth century?] postcards, half of which were commercially produced and half of which appear to have been fashioned by Mr. Walker.

About the Collection

The photographer's daughter, Mrs. Stanley L. Smith, donated her father's work to the Chester County Historical Society in May 1989. Processing of the Benjamin M. Walker photograph collection was made possible by a grant from The Institute of Museum & Library Services, a Federal agency established by and Act of Congress in 1996 to improve museum, library, and information services.
