<b>Abstract</b>	The Lucie and Sidney Jean Windolph school photographs mostly date from 1931-1976 and measure .4 linear feet. The photographs include both class photos and individual student portraits from the Windolph sisters' time teaching at various schools in West Pikeland, PA.

## **Historical Note**

Lucie Windolph was born in 1917 in West Pikeland, PA and died in 2008 in East Pikeland, PA. She was a teacher at Franklin Hall School, Chester Springs School and Pickering Valley School.

Sidney Jean Windolph (who went by Jean) was born in 1919 in West Pikeland, PA and died in 2001 in Chester Springs, PA. Buried in Chester Springs, PA. She was a teacher at Spring Ford School, Mont Clare School, and Oaks Elementary School.

The Windolph sisters were the only children of J. Herbert (d.1957) and Mary Emily Rees Windolph. J. Herbert Windolph owned a farm in Chester Springs and was a 25-year member of the West Pikeland Township School Board. The family attended St. Peter's Lutheran Church in Upper Pikeland and the sisters attended Chester Springs School and Downingtown High School.

## **Scope and Contents note**

The Lucie and Sidney Jean Windolph school photographs date from 1889-circa 1980, with a bulk date of 1931-1976, and measure .4 linear feet. The photographs include both class photos and individual student portraits from the Windolph sisters' time teaching at various schools in West Pikeland, PA.

The first series includes class photographs from 1906-1976 from Chester Springs School, Downingtown High School, Hillside School, Mont Clare School, Oaks Elementary School, Pickering Valley School, and West Pikeland High School.

The second series contains professional portraits of Lucie and Sidney Jean Windolph from 1946; 1966-1971.

The third series contains student portraits from Chester Springs School, Oaks Elementary School, and unidentified schools from 1947-1969. Many of the students are unidentified.
