Historical Note

The Fame Fire Company of West Chester, PA is a volunteer fire company established on February 22, 1838. While the First West Chester Fire Company and the Good Will Fire Company consisted of West Chester's elite, Fame consisted of young clerks and artisans who did not even make enough money to be taxed.

Fame's original location was on the grounds of the Chester County Courthouse. The company's first call was on March 28, 1838, and they were not called again until a year later. After great success in their second call at Taylor's Brew House, members elected Samuel S. Heed as president in 1840. In 1845, Fame purchased a fire engine from Philadelphia for \$900 and relocated to a lot owned by John T. Worthington on the north side of Market Street, between High and Walnut Streets.

Thomas Taylor (d.1904) was a notable photographer and community member in West Chester, PA. He moved to West Chester with his family at age five, then to Philadelphia, and finally back to West Chester in 1860 for the remainder of his life. He enlisted in the 124th Regiment, Pennsylvania Volunteers, during the Civil War and fought in the Battles of Antietam and Chancellorsville.

Before the war, Taylor learned photography in Philadelphia and he established a photography business on Gay Street in West Chester after his service.

An active member of the community, Taylor was a founding member of the Brandywine Baseball Club, Captain of the West Chester Rifle Team, and served as the Chester County Clerk of Courts and on the West Chester Borough Council.

Scope and Contents note

The Fame Fire Company portraits date from 1891-1892 and 1900 and measure .75 linear feet. The portraits were taken by Thomas W. Taylor and include 81 cabinet cards depicting the members of Fame Fire Company.

The 145 cabinet card portraits are arranged in alphabetical order by the last name of the man depicted in the portrait.

Arrangement note

This collection is arranged alphabetically by the sitter's last name.

Administrative Information

As of 2021, no accession record has been located for this collection. The accession number, 1948.8, comes only from the description in the Past Perfect catalog record. This description also states that the collection was donated to the Chester County Historical Society by the Fame Fire Company.
